| Child Care Resources | <p>Child Care Resources opened up the floor with questions. They touched base on what their current funding looks like, and how that impacts their services and response time, and the clients RRH case managers can refer. They talked about process, eligibility, services and their roles when working with DSHS services. | Group discussion | <p>Conversation included coordinated entry for all referrals. Went over what the CEA referrals looks like now, versus the ones we had been working with. Going over when a mobility request is appropriate.
