Changes to CEA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provided update on reassessment process and banding prioritization• All RRH providers can start receiving referrals through BitFocus• A family only has to complete a HMIS consent once
RRH Focus Groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Focus groups have been set for the end of May/beginning of June• Proposal and question was distributed to RRH providers <p data-bbox="418 632 542 659">Next steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create advertisement• Identify facilitators/note takers• Recruit families
Results of the work group report out	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• (See presentation for summary) <p data-bbox="418 898 542 926">Next steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Everyone uses same screening criteria (no screening criteria or preconditions beyond income and homeless status required by contracts)• Start using data again to measure success and learn from programs who are doing well• Connect with funders on which procedures/policies can be adopted by all now and which need more work for fidelity
