Signing up for this advanced training series includes an investment of and commitment to time and organizational change. **Eligibility requirements:** Staff from your organization have already received training in trauma-informed care; agency leadership able to make organizational changes to policies and practices are on board; your agency has 1-2 staff able to lead internal communities of practices to support change for at least six months.

### **ABOUT THE TRAINING SERIES – *What will you get?***

Learn how to incorporate trauma-informed principles into your organizational practice – specifically for agencies working with people experiencing homelessness.

**Access and utilization of the TICOMETER**, a standardized TIC instrument developed by the Center for Social Innovation for pre and post evaluation of the extent to which trauma-informed principles are integrated into organizational practices.

**Trauma-Informed Supervision and Leadership webinar** to explore your role and increase skills in supporting staff exposed to secondary trauma.

**5 TIC webinars** to identify strategies to infuse a trauma-informed perspective into daily practice, organizational structures and the program environment.

**1/2-day training** for organization leads to develop a results-frame for championing and making change at the agency-level.

**Monthly community of practice conference calls** with consultation for all organization leads.

### **ABOUT THE COMMITMENT – *What will it take?***

**Minimum of 6 months of intensive learning and implementation** with the support of All Home and t3.

#### **Identifying 1-2 agency lead(s)** who will

- ▶ Serve as internal change champions and will lead internal communities of practice activities
- ▶ Serve as a liaison to the training coordinators
- ▶ Participate in a ½ -day leadership training
- ▶ Participate in monthly conference calls with other cohort leads for 6 months

#### **Participating in 6, 1 ½ -hour webinars**

- ▶ 1 webinar designed for supervisors and agency leadership
- ▶ 5 webinars designed for full agency (agencies are encouraged to view and participate in webinars together)

**Completing the TICOMETER** as a pre and post evaluation of trauma-informed practice with an opportunity to consult with the trainer to reflect on results

**Internal community of practice activities** to be determined by each agency
