Public Comment	Bill Kirland Hackett shared information coming out of the South King County Homeless Advisory Council (SKC HAC) regarding a recent discussion regarding the urgent need to address winter shelter in South King County. Given COVID-19 and current smoky air conditions, existing operations have become more challenging. The SKC HAC is asking for support from the CoC and elected officials to engage in and act on regional, winter shelter efforts.
Advisory Committee Updates	Colleen Echohawk provided an update on the status of the applications and Selection Committee review process.
